4 5 6 7 8 9	AN ORDINANCE introduced by Interim City Manager William E. Cochran, concerning the adoption of the 2021 International Existing Building Code and repeal of the Uniform Code for Building Conservation by amending Chapter 14.25 of the Topeka Municipal Code.
10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:
11	Section 1. That section 14.25.010, Adopted, of The Code of the City of
12	Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows.
13	Adopted.
14	(a) The Uniform Code for Building Conservation, 1997 Edition, published by
15	the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road,
16	Whittier, California, is hereby adopted by the City for existing buildings and historic
17	structures and is hereby incorporated herein as if fully set out.
18	(b) At least one copy of the Uniform Code for Building Conservation as
19	adopted in this chapter shall be on file with the City Clerk to be available for inspection
20	by the public during business hours.
21	International Existing Building Code (IEBC) – Adopted.
22	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b), the International Existing Building
23	Code (IEBC), 2021 Edition, as published by the International Code Council and
24	amended by this chapter, is hereby adopted as the code for the purpose of regulating
25	the repair, alteration, change of occupancy, addition to and relocation of existing
26	buildings.
27	(b) Appendices B, C and D are specifically not adopted herein.
28	Section 2. That section 14.25.020, Table 5-E, hazard categories and

classifications earthquake safety, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended as follows.

Table 5-E, hazard categories and classifications earthquake safety.

Table 5-E, hazard categories and classifications earthquake safety, of Chapter 5, Uniform Code for Building Conservation, 1997 Edition, is hereby specifically repealed.

IEBC - Copies on file in clerk's office.

At least one copy of the IEBC, as amended, shall be on file with the city clerk to be available for inspection by the public at all reasonable business hours.

Section 3. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.030 which said section reads as follows:

Generally.

The amendments to the IEBC adopted herein shall be set out in this chapter. All references to section and chapter numbers shall be construed as if followed by the words "of the International Existing Building Code," unless clearly indicated otherwise.

<u>Section 4</u>. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.040, which said section reads as follows:

Section 103, Code Compliance Agency.

Section 103, Code Compliance Agency, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:

The development services division shall be responsible for the implementation, administration and enforcement of the provisions of this code. Any reference to "Department of Building Safety" will mean the development services division. Whenever the term "code official" is used in the IEBC, it shall be construed to mean to

development	services	division	director	or	designee.
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<u>Section 5</u>. That the Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.050, which said section reads as follows:

104.2.1, Determination of substantially improved or substantially damaged existing buildings and structures in flood hazard areas.

Section 104.2.1, Determination of substantially improved or substantially damaged existing buildings and structures in flood hazard areas, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:

For applications for reconstruction, rehabilitation, repair, alteration, additions or other improvement of existing buildings or structures located in flood hazard areas, the building official shall determine whether the proposed work constitutes substantial improvement or repair of substantial damage. Where the building official determines that the proposed work constitutes substantial improvement or repair of substantial damage, the building official shall require the building to meet the requirements provided in the TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30 (floodplain management).

<u>Section 6</u>. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.060, which said section reads as follows:

104.10.1, Flood hazard areas.

Section 104.10.1, Flood hazard areas, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:

For existing buildings located in flood hazard areas for which repairs, alterations and additions constitute substantial improvement, the code official

75	shall not grant modifications to provisions related to flood resistance, except as
76	provided in TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30 (floodplain
77	management).
78	Section 7. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
79	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.070, which said section reads as follows:
80	Section 105, Permits.
81	Section 105, Permits, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision
82	shall be substituted therefor:
83	Any owner or owner's authorized agent who intends to repair, add to,
84	alter, relocate, demolish, or change the occupancy of a building or to repair,
85	install, add, alter, remove, convert, or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical, or
86	plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by this chapter, or to
87	cause any such work to be performed, shall first apply to the code official and
88	obtain a permit, if required by TMC Title 14.
89	Section 8. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
90	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.080, which said section reads as follows:
91	109.3.3, Lowest floor elevation.
92	Section 109.3.3, Lowest floor elevation, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the
93	following provision shall be substituted therefor:
94	For additions and substantial improvements to existing buildings in flood
95	hazard areas, upon placement of the lowest floor, including basement, and prior
96	to further vertical construction, any elevation documentation required in Chapter

14.20 TMC or Chapter 17.30 TMC shall be submitted to the code official.

98	Section 9. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
99	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.090, which said section reads as follows:
100	112, Means of Appeals.
101	Section 112, Means of Appeals, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following
102	provision shall be substituted therefor:
103	Appeals of orders, decisions or determinations made by the code official
104	relative to the application and interpretation of this code shall be considered by
105	the Board of Building and Fire Appeals pursuant to TMC Chapter 2.235.
106	Section 10. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
107	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.100, which said section reads as follows:
108	113.4, Violation penalties.
109	Section 113.4, Violation penalties, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the
110	following provision shall be substituted therefor:
111	Violation of any provision of TMC 14.25.010 shall constitute a
112	misdemeanor. Any person who violates any provision of TMC 14.25.010 or fails
113	to comply with any of its requirements shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not
114	to exceed \$499.00. Each day such violation continues shall be considered a
115	separate offense.
116	Section 11. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
117	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.110, which said section reads as follows:
118	115, Unsafe Structures and Equipment; 116, Emergency Measures; 117,
119	Demolition.
120	Sections 115 through 117 are deleted in their entirety.

121	Section 12. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
122	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.120, which said section reads as follows:
123	201.3, Terms defined in other codes.
124	Section 201.3, Terms defined in other codes, is hereby deleted in its entirety and
125	the following provision shall be substituted therefor:
126	(a) Where terms are not defined in this code and are defined in other codes,
127	such terms shall have the meanings ascribed to them in those codes.
128	Any reference to the following codes in the IEBC will be deleted and replaced with
129	the following codes:
130	• International Property Maintenance Code is replaced with the property
131	maintenance code, adopted in Chapter 8.60 TMC.
132	• International Building Code is replaced with the building code, adopted in
133	Chapter 14.20 TMC.
134	• Electrical Code is replaced with the electrical code, adopted in Chapter 14.30
135	TMC.
136	• International Plumbing Code is replaced with the plumbing code, adopted in
137	Chapter 14.35 TMC.
138	• International Fire Code is replaced with the fire code, adopted in Chapter
139	14.40 TMC.
140	International Mechanical Code is replaced with the mechanical code, adopted
141	in Chapter 14.50 TMC.
142	International Residential Code is replaced with the residential code, adopted in
143	Chapter 14.55 TMC.

(b) Any reference to the sections in Chapter 11 of the 2015 International Fire Code will be deleted and replaced with applicable sections of the IEBC unless the building code official, in consultation with the fire code official, determines that the public's health and safety is better served by following the applicable provisions of the Life Safety Code adopted at TMC 14.45.010.

Section 13. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.130, which said section reads as follows:

302.2, Additional codes.

Section 302.2, Additional codes, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:

Alterations, repairs, additions and changes of occupancy to, or relocation of, existing buildings and structures shall comply with the provisions for alterations, repairs, additions, and changes of occupancy or relocation, respectively, in this code and the following codes: NFPA 70, TMC Chapter 14 (energy conservation codes); TMC Chapter 14.40 (fire code); TMC Chapter 14.50 (mechanical code); TMC Chapter 14.55 (residential code); and TMC Chapter 14.35 (plumbing code). Where provision of the other codes conflict with provisions of this code, the provisions of this code shall take precedence.

<u>Section 14</u>. That the Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.140, which said section reads as follows:

306, Accessibility For Existing Buildings.

Section 306, Accessibility for Existing Buildings, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:

Applicable city ordinances, state and federal statutes and implementing regulations concerning accessibility shall apply to maintenance, change of occupancy, additions and alterations to existing buildings, including those identified as historic buildings.

Section 15. That the Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.150, which said section reads as follows:

502.3, Flood hazard areas.

Section 502.3. Flood hazard areas, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:

For buildings and structures in flood hazard areas established in Section 1612.3 of the International Building Code, or Section R322 of the International Residential Code, as applicable, any addition that constitutes substantial improvement of the existing structure shall comply with the requirements provided in the TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30 (floodplain management). Additions to buildings and structures in such flood hazard areas that do not constitute substantial improvement are not required to comply to meet the requirements provided in the TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30 (floodplain management).

Section 16. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.160, which said section reads as follows:

503.2, Flood hazard areas.

Section 503.2, Flood hazard areas, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:

For buildings and structures in flood hazard areas established in Section 1612.3 of the International Building Code, or Section R322 of the International Residential Code, as applicable, any alteration that constitutes substantial improvement of the existing structure shall comply with the requirements provided in the TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30 (floodplain management). Alterations to buildings and structures in such flood hazard areas that do not constitute substantial improvement are not required to comply to meet the requirements provided in the TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30 (floodplain management).

Section 17. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.170, which said section reads as follows:

507.3, Flood hazard areas.

Section 507.3. Flood hazard areas, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:

In flood hazard areas, repairs that constitute substantial improvement shall require that the building comply with the requirements provided in the TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30 (floodplain management).

Section 18. That the Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.180, which said section reads as follows:

701.3, Flood hazard areas.

Section 701.3, Flood hazard areas, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the

213	following provision shall be substituted therefor:
214	In flood hazard areas, alterations that constitute substantial improvement
215	shall require that the building comply with TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code),
216	14.55 (residential code), as applicable, and 17.30 (floodplain management).
217	Section 19. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
218	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.190, which said section reads as follows:
219	702.7.1, International Fuel Gas Code.
220	Section 702.7.1, International Fuel Gas Code, is hereby deleted in its entirety.
221	Section 20. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
222	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.200, which said section reads as follows:
223	705, Reroofing.
224	Section 705, Reroofing, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following
225	provision shall be substituted therefor:
226	Materials and methods of application used for recovering or replacing an
227	existing roof covering shall comply with TMC Chapter 14.20.
228	Section 21. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
229	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.210, which said section reads as follows:
230	708.1, Minimum requirements.
231	Section 708.1, Minimum requirements, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the
232	following provision shall be substituted therefor:
233	Level 1 alterations to existing buildings or structures are permitted without
234	requiring the entire building or structure to comply with the energy requirements
235	of TMC Chapter 14.55 (residential code) and the energy conservation codes in

236	TMC Chapter 14. The alterations shall conform to the requirements in TMC
237	Chapter 14.55 and the energy conservation codes as they relate to new
238	construction only.
239	Section 22. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
240	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.220, which said section reads as follows:
241	1103.3, Flood hazard areas.
242	Section 1103.3, Flood hazard areas, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the
243	following provisions shall be substituted therefor:
244	Additions and foundations in flood hazard areas shall comply with TMC
245	Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30 (floodplain management).
246	Section 23. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
247	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.230, which said section reads as follows:
248	1201.4, Flood hazard areas.
249	Section 1201.4, Flood hazard areas, except for the provision marked "Exception,"
250	is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following provision shall be substituted therefor:
251	In flood hazard areas, if all proposed work, including repairs, work
252	required because of a change of occupancy, and alterations, constitutes
253	substantial improvement, then the existing building shall comply with the
254	requirements provided in the TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30
255	(floodplain management).
256	Section 24. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
257	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.240, which said section reads as follows:
258	1402.6, Flood hazard areas.

259	Section 1402.6, Flood hazard areas, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the
260	following provision shall be substituted therefor:
261	If relocated or moved into a flood hazard area, structures shall comply with
262	the requirements provided in the TMC Chapters 14.20 (building code) and 17.30
263	(floodplain management).
264	Section 25. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
265	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.250, which said section reads as follows:
266	1301.4.1, Structural analysis.
267	Section 1301.4.1, Structural analysis, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the
268	following provision shall be substituted therefor:
269	The owner shall have a structural analysis of the existing building made to
270	determine adequacy of structural systems for the proposed alteration, addition or
271	change of occupancy. The analysis shall demonstrate that the building with the
272	work completed meets the structural provisions of IEBC Chapters 4, 6-12, and
273	<u>14.</u>
274	Section 26. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended
275	by adding a section, to be numbered 14.25.260, which said section reads as follows:
276	1508.1, Construction sites.
277	Section 1508.1, Construction sites, is hereby deleted in its entirety and the
278	following provision shall be substituted therefor:
279	Structures, sites, and equipment directly associated with the actual
280	process of construction, including but not limited to scaffolding, bridging, material

hoists, material storage, or construction trailers shall comply with city ordinances,

282	state and rederal statutes and implementing regulations for accessibility.
283	Section 27. That original § 14.25.010 and § 14.25.020 of The Code of the City
284	of Topeka, Kansas, are hereby specifically repealed.
285	Section 28. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on April 1, 2022
286	after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
287	Section 29. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,
288	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
289	Section 30. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared
290	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
291	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
