ORDINANCE NO. 20209

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Brent Trout, repealing § 2.140.160 through § 2.140.290 of the Topeka Municipal Code related to Police and Fire Pension Funds.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body approved Ordinance No. 20206 on September 10, 2019, that amended, repealed and created several sections of Title 2 of the Topeka Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Article IV of Chapter 2.140, related to Police and Fire Pension funds, was intended to have been repealed due to the fact that these local plans were abolished 40 years ago; and

WHEREAS, the language required to repeal this particular article was inadvertently omitted from the above-referenced ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Code Publishing Company requires that this oversight be corrected as soon as possible in order to proceed with the recodification process.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Article IV, in Chapter 2.140 TMC, Police and Fire Pension Funds, § 2.140.160 through § 2.140.290, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.

Section 3. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules, or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
