22	Section 2.	That section 11.10.010, Hours, of The Code of the City of Topeka,		
23	Kansas, is hereby r	enumbered as 11.05.010 and amended to read as follows:

25	(a) It sha	Il be unlawful for any person, except a public officer or employee in		
26	the discharge of the	neir dutiesduty or those specifically authorized by the Director or		
27	designee of the Sh	awnee County Department of Parks and Recreations, to visit, loiter		
28	about or be found	in any public park in the City after the hour of 11:00 p.m. and until		
29	6:00 a.m. of the following	owing day unless specifically authorized by the Director or designee		
30	of the Shawnee Co	unty Department of Parks and Recreation.		

31	(b) It shall be unlawful for any person, except a public officer or employee in		
32	the discharge of duty or those specifically authorized by the Friends of the Topeka Zoo		
33	("FOTZ"), in accordance with the License and Management Agreement dated February		
34	9, 2021, and amendments thereto, to visit, loiter about or be found in the Gage		
35	ParkTopeka Zoo and Conservation Center from a time beginning one hour after sunset		
36	of each day until sunrise of the following day unless specifically authorized by the City of		
37	Topeka Zoological Department Director or designee after 11:00 p.m. and until 6:00 a.m.		
38	the following day.		
39	Section 3. That section 11.25.010, Acceptance by City, of The Code of the		
40	City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

42	The proposal of the trustees of the Munn Memorial is hereby accepted by the		
43	City.		
44	Section 4. That section 11.25.020, Land dedicated in Gage Park, of The Code		
45	of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby renumbered as 11.10.020 and amended to

47	Land dedicated in Gage Park Acceptance of Property by City.		
48	(a) The City hereby accepts from Louisa H. Gage a tract of land consisting of		
49	the northeast corner of Gage Park dedicated as the Topeka Zoological Park.		
50	(b) There is hereby appropriated and perpetually dedicated for the creation		

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thereon of the memorial monument to the native sons and daughters of the State of

Kansas, provided for in the will of The City hereby accepts from Lillie G. Munn, a tract

and parcel of land located in Gage Park, to be agreed upon by the Board of

Commissioners with the trustees dedicated for a memorial monument to the native sons and daughters of the State of Kansas.

Section 5. That section 11.25.030, City to landscape and maintain, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby renumbered as 11.10.030 and amended to read as follows:

City to landscape and maintain Munn Memorial.

In consideration of the erection of the Munn Memorial, the City, hereby agrees to appropriately or its designee, shall landscape the tract, and to perpetually protect and maintain the monument for the use of the public of the City and of the State.

Section 6. That section 11.35.010, Statement of purpose, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby renumbered as 11.10.010 and amended to read as follows:

Statement of pPurpose.

- (a) The City Council hereby finds that purpose of the Topeka Zoological Park, dedicated and established pursuant to TMC 11.35.020, shall be utilized for the purpose of providing is to provide the citizens of Topeka and others with opportunities to learn about our natural world, to increase scientific knowledge that benefits nature conservation, to support conservation of endangered populations and habitats, and to participate in activities that improve the quality of life in the community.
- (b) These opportunities can best be provided in partnerships with support groups such as the Friends of the Topeka Zoo, Inc., and the Topeka Zoological Foundation, and in cooperation with local, State, national and international education and conservation institutions, organizations and governments.

77	Section 7. That section 11.35.020, Dedication, of The Code of the City of		
78	Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.		
79	Dedication.		
80	There is hereby appropriated and dedicated as Topeka Zoological Park the		
81	following described tract of land:		
82	The northeast corner of Gage Park containing the Zoological Park area.		
83	Section 8. That section 11.35.030, Advisory body, of The Code of the City of		
84	Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.		
85	Advisory body.		
86	The Topeka Friends of the Zoo, Inc., is hereby recognized as an advisory body of		
87	the Zoological Park Department.		
88	Section 9. That section 11.35.040, Protection of zoo, of The Code of the City		
89	of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.		
90	Protection of zoo.		
91	The City Council shall, when deemed necessary, pass such ordinances as will		
92	enable the Zoological Park Department and the Topeka Friends of the Zoo, Inc., to		
93	efficiently protect and care for the dedicated property and to promote the purposes of		
94	the Topeka Zoological Park.		
95	Section 10. That section 11.35.050, Concessions and admissions, of The Code		
96	of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.		
97	Concessions and admissions.		
98	The Zoological Park Department is hereby granted exclusive authority to operate		
99	admissions and concessions by way of purchasing and selling products or by		
100	authorizing a third party to provide admissions and concessions services at the Topeka		

Zoo. Proceeds from such services, if operated by the Zoological Park Department, shall
be credited to the revenue account fund established by the Director of Budget and
Financial Services pursuant to TMC 3.25.010 and shall first be used to pay the
expenses thereof, and any excess shall be used for the operation, maintenance, and
improvement of the Topeka Zoological Park. Any authorization allowing third party
provision of admissions and/or concessions operations must be approved by the City
Manager.

<u>Section 11.</u> That section 11.35.060, Admission fees, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

Admission fees.

The City Manager or designee shall establish all fees for admission to the Topeka Zoo and shall have full discretion to waive fees and offer discounts and promotions.

Section 12. That section 11.35.080, Disposition of fees, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

Disposition of fees.

All moneys derived from the fees established in TMC 11.35.060 less operational costs of the collection thereof shall be deposited into the City's general fund.

Section 13. That the Code of the City of Topeka, Kanas is hereby amended by adding a section, to be numbered 11.10.040, which said section reads as follows:

Topeka Zoo and Conservation Center - Management and operation.

(a) Because the ability to advance the purposes set out in TMC 11.10.010 within the Topeka Zoo and Conservation Center can be more efficiently and effectively provided through a public-private partnership, the Governing Body has authorized a

125	License and Management Agreement, on February 9, 2021, with the Friends of the
126	Topeka Zoo, Inc. ("FOTZ"). The Governing Body shall, when deemed necessary, pass
127	such ordinances as will (i) protect and care for the Topeka Zoological Park and (ii)
128	assist FOTZ with its efforts to efficiently and effectively manage and operate the Topeka
129	Zoo and Conservation Center to promote these established purposes.
130	(b) As evidence of the public-private partnership between the City and FOTZ,
131	one (1) elected official of the City shall be appointed as a voting member and two (2)
132	staff members of the City shall be appointed as ex officio members to FOTZ's Board of
133	Directors and shall attend meetings and have access to all pertinent documents, as
134	more specifically set out in the License and Management Agreement dated February 9,
135	2021, and amendments thereto.
136	(c) FOTZ shall be entitled to collect, receive, retain and use for the benefit of
137	the Topeka Zoo and Conservation Center all revenues derived from the operations of
138	the Zoo unless explicitly excluded by the terms of the License and Management
139	Agreement dated February 9, 2021, and amendments thereto.
140	Section 14. That original § 11.10.010 and § 11.25.030 of The Code of the City
141	of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby specifically repealed.
142	Section 15. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
143	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
144	Section 16. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,
145	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
146	Section 17. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared
147	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
148	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
