30	(a) Before 9:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday;		
31	(b) Before 12:00 noon 9:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m. on Sunday; or		
32	(c) On Easter, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas Day.		
33	Section 4. That original § 9.15.100 and § 9.15.250 of The Code of the City of		
34	Topeka, Kansas, are hereby specifically repealed.		
35	Section 5. This ordinance shall be published at least once each week for two		
36	consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper. The ordinance shall become effective		
37	60 days from the date of the second publication unless a petition is filed requesting that		
38	a proposition be submitted for approval by the voters pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2911, as		
39	amended by 2021 H.B. 2137, Sec. 38. If a valid petition is filed, this ordinance shall not		
40	become effective unless a proposition is submitted to and approved at an election.		
41	Section 6. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,		
42	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.		
43	Section 7. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared		
44	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this		
45	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
