11	Section 1. Amendments to the Budget incorporated by reference as a part of this							
12	Ordinance. The amendments to the operating budget for the City of Topeka, Kansas, for							
13	the year 2021 as set forth in a document in the format prescribed by the Director of							
14	Accounts and Reports of the Kansas Department of Administration, as required by law,							
15	which has been published in a summary format together with a notice of public hearing, is							
16	hereby incorporated by reference as a part of this Ordinance with the same force and							
17	effect as if it were set forth herein in its entirety.							
18	Section 2. Amendments to the Budget approved and adopted. The amendments							
19	to the operating budget as described and incorporated by reference in Section 1 above are							
20	hereby approved and adopted as amendments to the operating budget for the year 2021.							
21	Section 3. Funds appropriated by budget. The amendments to the budget as							
22	approved and adopted herein shall constitute and shall be declared to be appropriations for							
23	the funds and departments as set forth therein, and the appropriations thus made shall not							
24	be used for any other purpose. No money in any fund or fund type shall be used to pay for							
25	any indebtedness created in excess of the amount appropriated for such fund or fund type,							
26	or for the departments of such fund or fund type as referred to in the operating budget.							
27	The appropriations made herein are for the year 2021 and no expenditures shall be							

incurred as being authorized by such appropriations prior to January 1, 2021 or

30	Section 4. Budget amendments. Any further amendment to the operating budget								
31	must be approved by the Governing Body and enacted in accordance with the provisions of								
32	K.S.A. § 79-2929a.								
33	Section 5. As used in this ordinance "fund" is defined as follows:								
34	Fund. A fiscal and accounting entity with a self balancing set of accounts in which								
35	cash and other financial resources, all related liabilities and residual equities, or balance								
36	and changes therein are recorded and segregated to carry on specific activities or attain								
37	certain objectives in accordance with special regulations, restrictions, or limitations.								
38	Section 6. The following fund types are authorized:								
39	Governmental (or statutory) Fund Type: including General Fund, Special Revenue								
40	Funds, Debt Service Funds, and Capital Projects Funds; Proprietary Fund Type: including								
41	Enterprise Funds and Internal Service Funds (fixed or flexible); and, Fiduciary Fund Type:								
42	including Trust and Agency Funds. This Ordinance applies to all funds as listed on the								
43	budget certificate and fund summary adopted and submitted to the county and state.

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2021 Budget Amendment Summary

Below is a summary of each of the proposed amendments to the 2021 budget.

Information Technology (613)

The 2021 adopted budget is \$4,162,087 we recommend amending to \$4,337,087

This additional \$125,000 is made up of additional costs as a result of the Cybersecurity audit findings, city hall renovation costs, and an increase in payroll expense over what was budgeted in '21. And \$50,000 for Utilities phone system.

Federal Funds Exchange (276)

The 2021 adopted budget is \$774,811 we recommend amending to \$ 1,562,166

The City of Topeka enters into a master agreement with the Kansas Department of Transportation for use of federal and state transportation funding. In 2019, the City set up a fund to better track the revenue and expenditures of these federal and state funds. This fund has received \$1,562,166 of revenue in 2021 and the recommendation is to approve an expenditure budget to match the revenues received.

121006.00 – Has \$1,200,000 approved on 2021 CIP. Will be more spending this year, possibly all of it.

121014.00 – Has \$200,000 approved on 2021 CIP. Mostly spent, remaining most likely spent this year.

601109.03 – \$22,590 for Remix software that was done by previous City Engineer and Kristi. Not on any CIP but will need to come out of FFF.
