10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:		
11	Section 1.	That section 10.35.030, Bicycles, electric-assisted scooters, roller	
12	skates and skateboards – Prohibited areas, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas,		
13	is hereby amended to read as follows:		
14	Bicycles,	electric-assisted scooters, roller skates and skateboards –	
15	Prohibited areas.		
16	(a) It sha	all be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle, operate an electric-	
17	assisted scooter, skate or use roller skates, skateboards, roller blades, or other similar		
18	devices in the following areas:		
19	(1)	Public sidewalks and pocket parks in an area bounded by 6th	
20	Street and 10th Street along Kansas Avenue; and		
21	(2)	Public parking facilities; and.	
22	<u>(3)</u>	Public sidewalks in the following areas:	
23		(i) N Kansas Avenue between NE Norris Street and NE Morse	
24	Stree	<u>:t;</u>	
25		(ii) NE Morse Street between NE Quincy Street and NW Central	
26	Aven	ue;	
27		(iii) NE Gordon Street between NE Quincy Street and NW	
28	Jackson Street;		
29		(iv) NE Laurent Street between NE Quincy Street and NW	

30	Jackson Street;		
31	(v) NE Norris Street between NE Quincy Street and NW		
32	Jackson Street.		
33	(4) Redbud and Breezeway Parks.		
34	(b) Any person who rides a bicycle, operates an electric-assisted scooter, or		
35	uses roller skates, skateboards, roller blades, or other similar devices on a public		
36	sidewalk shall:		
37	(1) Yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and give an audible signal		
38	before overtaking and passing pedestrians; and		
39	(2) Travel at a speed that is reasonable and prudent under existing		
40	conditions, except that an operator of an electric-assisted scooter shall not travel		
41	at a speed that exceeds 15 miles per hour.		
42	(c) This section shall not apply to a law enforcement officer engaged in		
43	the performance of official duties.		
44	Section 2. That original § 10.35.030 of The Code of the City of Topeka,		
45	Kansas, is hereby specifically repealed.		
46	Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its		
47	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.		
48	Section 4. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,		
49	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.		
50	Section 5. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared		
51	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this		
52	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
