11	Section 1. That section 10.35.030, Bicycles, electric-assisted scooters, roller

13	is hereby amended to read as follows:		
14	Bicycles, electric-assisted scooters, roller skates and skateboards –		
15	Prohibited areas.		
16	(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle, operate an electric-		
17	assisted scooter, skate or use roller skates, skateboards, roller blades, or other similar		
18	devices in the following areas:		
19	(1) Public sidewalks and pocket parks in an area bounded by 6th		
20	Street and 10th Street along Kansas Avenue; and		
21	(2) Public parking facilities; and		
22	(3) Public sidewalks in the following areas:		
23	(i) N Kansas Avenue between NE Norris Street and NE Morse		
24	Street;		
25	(ii) NE Morse Street between NE Quincy Street and NW Central		
26	Avenue;		
27	(iiiii) NE Gordon Street between NE Quincy Street and NW		
28	Jackson Street;		
29	(iviii) NE Laurent Street between NE Quincy Street and NW

(4) Redbud and Breezeway Parks.

34 (b) Any person who rides a bicycle, operates an electric-assisted scooter, or 35 uses roller skates, skateboards, roller blades, or other similar devices on a public 36 sidewalk shall:

37 (1) Yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and give an audible signal
38 before overtaking and passing pedestrians; and

39 (2) Travel at a speed that is reasonable and prudent under existing
40 conditions, except that an operator of an electric-assisted scooter shall not travel
41 at a speed that exceeds 15 miles per hour.

42 (c) This section shall not apply to a law enforcement officer engaged in43 the performance of official duties.

44 <u>Section 2</u>. That original § 10.35.030 of The Code of the City of Topeka,
45 Kansas, is hereby specifically repealed.

- 46 <u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
 47 passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
- 48 <u>Section 4</u>. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,
 49 or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.
- 50 <u>Section 5</u>. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared 51 invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this 52 ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
