9 10	WHEREAS, on April 12, 2022, the Governing Body passed Resolution No. 9297
11	which authorized the issuance, sale and delivery of taxable general obligation temporary
12	notes; and
13	WHEREAS, the notes were to pay for the costs of improvement for four projects,
14	one of which the Hi-Crest street repair/replacement (Project No. 601139.00) in the amount
15	of \$612,105.00; and
16	WHEREAS, the Hi-Crest Neighborhood Improvement Association ("NIA") has
17	requested that the Hi-Crest project be changed from street repair/replacement to private
18	housing and housing rehabilitation; and
19	WHEREAS, the Home Rule Amendment, Art. 12, Section 5 of the Kansas
20	Constitution, authorizes the Governing Body to issue general obligation bonds to finance
21	private housing and housing rehabilitation which promote the public health, safety and
22	welfare of the City; and
23	WHEREAS, the Governing Body finds it necessary and advisable to authorize the
24	use of proceeds from the Series 2022-A taxable general obligation temporary notes for
25	private housing and housing rehabilitation in the NIA.
26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
27	CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that the proceeds from the Series 2022-A taxable general
28	obligation temporary notes may be used for private housing and housing rehabilitation

29	projects approved by the NIA in an amount not to exceed \$612,105.00, pursuant to Art
30	12, Section 5 of the Kansas Constitution.
