5 A CHARTER ORDINANCE introduced by Mayor Joan Wagnon relating to the code of
6 procedure for municipal courts; providing for substitute and
7 additional provisions; and expressly repealing Charter
8 Ordinance No. 29, Charter Ordinance No. 36, Charter
9 Ordinance No. 37, Charter Ordinance No. 42, and Charter
10 Ordinance No. 48.

12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

14 Section 1. Pursuant to Article 12, § 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas,
15 the City of Topeka, Kansas, elects to exempt itself and make inapplicable to it, the
16 provisions of K.S.A. 12-4101 through K.S.A. 12-4602, and amendments thereto, all
17 governing the code of procedure for municipal courts, and elects to provide substitute and
18 additional provisions as hereinafter set forth.

19 Section 2. The City Council shall adopt, by ordinary ordinance, any provisions
20 relating to the code of procedure for municipal courts.

21 Section 3. Charter Ordinance No. 29, Charter Ordinance No. 36, Charter
22 Ordinance No. 37, Charter Ordinance No. 42, and Charter Ordinance No. 48 are hereby
23 repealed.

24 Section 4. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2)
25 consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

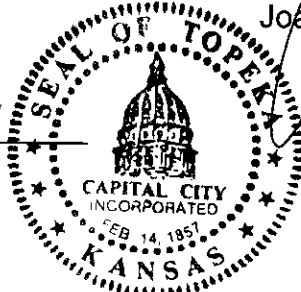
26 Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force the 61st day after its
27 passage, approval, and final publication in the official city newspaper, unless a valid
28 petition demanding a referendum is filed with the city clerk within 60 days after the final
29 publication.
