CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 88

A CHARTER ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmembers Clark Duffy, Gary Price, Duane Pomeroy, John Alcala and Harold Lane increasing the transient guest tax from five percent to six percent through December 31, 2015 and amending Charter Ordinance Section A15-17 and repealing original said section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That City of Topeka Code § A15-17, Levied; amount, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Levied; amount.**

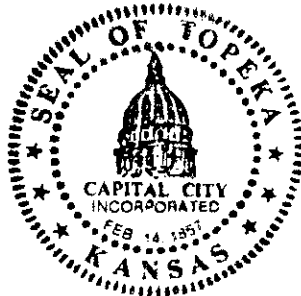
a. Beginning with the effective date of this Charter Ordinance as provided in section 3 herein, and continuing through December 31, 2015, A a transient guest tax of five ~~six~~ percent shall be levied in the City of Topeka, Kansas, upon the gross rental receipts derived from or paid by transient guests for lodging or sleeping accommodations, exclusive of charges for incidental services or facilities, in any hotel, motel, or tourist court. The effective date of said tax shall be December 15, 1986, subject to the conditions and provisions of section 13 herein [not set out in this division].


b. Effective January 1, 2016, a transient guest tax of five percent shall be levied in the City of Topeka, Kansas, upon the gross rental receipts derived from or paid by transient guests for lodging or sleeping accommodations, exclusive of charges for incidental services or facilities, in any hotel, motel, or tourist court.

Section 2. That original Charter Ordinance section A15-17 is hereby repealed.


Section 3. This charter ordinance shall take effect and be in force the 61<sup>st</sup> day after its passage, approval and final publication in the official city newspaper, unless a valid petition demanding a referendum is filed with the city clerk within sixty (60) days after the final publication.
