| 40 | WHEREAS, the governing body of the City has, in accordance with the |
| 41 | Constitution, passed and approved its Charter Ordinance No. 90, May 27, 2003, as |
| 42 | amended and as codified in Topeka City Code § A2-18 and published, recorded, and |
| 43 | filed the same with the Secretary of the State, hereinafter referred to as "Charter |
| 44 | Ordinance No. 90" and, as such, exempted itself from the Act and provided certain |
| 45 | substitute and additional provisions to the Act; and |
| 46 | WHEREAS, the City now wishes to amend Charter Ordinance No. 90 which, in |
| 47 | accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, may be accomplished only upon |
| 48 | either the adoption of a charter ordinance of the City or by an enactment of the state |
| 49 | legislature applicable to all cities of the State. |

52 <u>Section 1</u>. That Topeka City Code § A2-18, Council Districts, is hereby 53 amended to read as follows:

- (a) Number of districts. There shall be nine (9) council districts.
- (b) Council districts. The districts from which the City of Topeka councilmembers shall be nominated shall be based on the ward and precinct descriptions as follows, effective January 1, 2003:

(c) Revision of boundary lines. In July of 1992 and in July of every tenth (10th) year thereafter, the council shall appoint a commission of electors of the city who shall examine the plan of districts and shall, by September 30th of each such year,

recommend to the council such revisions in the boundary lines of the nine (9) districts so as to meet the requirements stated below in subsection 2.3D [subsection (d) of this section]. On or prior to December 31st of each such year, the council by ordinary ordinance shall reestablish the district boundaries as recommended by the commission of electors or shall reject in whole or in part the recommendations of the commission of electors and reestablish the boundaries as it sees fit so as to meet the requirements stated below in subsection (d). The council shall certify the boundaries so reestablished to the election commission of Shawnee County. The commission appointed to recommend revisions to district lines in 1992 and subsequent commissions shall have at least one (1) elector from each district. The council may, by ordinary ordinance, establish specific commission procedure and membership requirements consistent with the general policies established by this Charter Ordinance.

Any territory hereafter annexed to or consolidated with the City of Topeka, Kansas, shall at the time of such annexation or consolidation be added to an adjacent district or districts by an ordinary ordinance of the council; provided, that if any territory annexed or consolidated prior to June 1 of the year preceding a city election shall contain qualified votes sufficient in number to upset the approximate equality of the established districts, the council shall provide for redistricting the city in accord with the procedures described in this section 2.3 [this section A2-18].

(d) Requirements for reestablishing district boundary lines. The boundary lines for the nine (9) districts from which district councilmembers shall be nominated shall be reestablished by the commission of electors and the council so as to:

| 95 | County election commissioner and be described in terms of the wards and |
| 96 | precincts contained in each district. |
| 97 | (4) Avoid use of number of registered voters by party or other partisan |
| 98 | data. |
| 99 | (5) Maintain, as much as possible, the integrity of broadly cohesive |
| 100 | areas of interest. |
| 101 | (6) Avoid boundary lines that result in a councilmember residing |
| 102 | outside his or her elected district during the councilmember's current term of |
| 103 | office. |
| 104 | Section 2. This Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) |
| 105 | consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper. |
| 106 | Section 3. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final |
