**ORDINANCE NO. 19031**

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-301001.00, which provides for replacing an existing pump station at Cypress Ridge Golf Course, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby authorized, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka that the following public improvement be made:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide the replacement of a pump station at Cypress Ridge Golf Course that is over 30 years old. Replacement parts for certain elements of the existing station are no longer available. The pump station is necessary to provide water to the golf course.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$125,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds	\$125,000.00
