4 **ORDINANCE NO. 19076**

6 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember John Alcala authorizing the sale,
7 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at Germanfest 2008 to
8 be held at the Sacred Heart-St. Joseph Parish on June 7 and 8, 2008.
9

10 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
11 TOPEKA, KANSAS:

12 Section 1. a) Authorization is given to barricade a portion of the Rowley Street
13 right-of-way at the pedestrian crossing between the Church building and the parking lot
14 east of Rowley on June 7, 2008, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. and on
15 June 8, 2008, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Attendance to the
16 Celebration is open to the public between these hours. Licensed retailers may sell non-
17 alcoholic commodities or food between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on June 7,
18 2008, and on June 8, 2008, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

19 b) The barricaded portion of the Rowley Street right-of-way at the pedestrian
20 crossing between the Church building and the parking lot east of Rowley between the hours
21 of 4:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on June 7, 2008, and on June 8, 2008, between the hours of
22 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and the
23 provisions of K.S.A. 41-719. Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of
24 Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and
25 municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of
26 Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of Rowley Street between the hours
27 of 4:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on June 7, 2008, and between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6:00
28 p.m. on June 8, 2008.

29 c) Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages in the
30 specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded
31 portion of Rowley Street between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on June 7, 2008,
32 and between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on June 8, 2008.

33 Section 2. This Ordinance shall be null and void on June 9, 2008.

34 Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage,
35 approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
