11	<u>Section</u>	1. That section 86-27, Composition; term of members, of The Co	de of	
12	the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:			
13	Composition; appointment; term of members.			
14	<u>(a)</u> <u>/</u>	Membership generally. The Topeka Human Relations Commission	shall	
15	consist of nine (9) members to be drawn from diverse racial, ethnic, commercial, and			
16	industrial segments of the community, who shall reside within the corporate limits of the			
17	city. The commissioners shall be appointed by the mayor from council nominations, and			
18	such appointments shall be confirmed by the council. Members shall serve without			
19	compensation.			
20	<u>(b)</u> 7	Terms. The term of office of each member of the commission shall be	e for	
21	two (2) years. Members shall not serve beyond the end of their appointed terms. Upon			
22	expiration of a term the position shall remain vacant until a successor is appointed.			
23	<u>(c)</u> <u>(</u>	Qualifications of members. No full or part time benefit eligible employ	ee or	
24	elected official of the city may be appointed to the commission. No immediate family			
25	member of a city councilmember, any department director or employee of the Topeka			
26	Human Relations Commission may be appointed to the commission.			
27	<u>(d)</u> <u>(</u>	Compensation and removal. Members shall serve without compens	ation.	
28	Members may	be removed for cause by a majority vote of the council. Remov	al for	

29	cause shall include but not be limited to the following reasons: failure to attend four (4			
30	commission meetings in one (1) calendar year or failure to attend three (3) consecutive			
31	commission meetings in one (1) calendar year. In the case of death, incapacity			
32	resignation or disqualification of any member of the commission, vacancies shall be			
33	filled in accordance with City of Topeka Code section 2-181.			
34	(e) Commission organization. The commission shall select by majority vote			
35	one of the appointees as the chairperson of the commission and one of the appointees			
36	as the vice-chairperson of the commission. The commission shall meet monthly. Specia			
37	meetings may be called by the chairperson or by a majority of the commission.			
38	Section 2. That original section 86-27 of The Code of the City of Topeka is			
39	hereby specifically repealed.			
40	Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its			
41	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
