10	WHEREAS, water and wastewater utility rate increases have a disproportionate				
11	impact on lower income customers; and				
12	WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka, Kansas, hereby finds that it is in the				
13	best interest of the City of Topeka to provide lower income customers with relief from rising				
14	municipal utility rates by establishing a water and wastewater utility rate refund program.				
15	WHEREAS, the State of Kansas has established a Homestead Program to provide a				
16	rebate of property taxes for certain eligible low income residents of Kansas; and				
17	WHEREAS, the State of Kansas has established criteria to determine which low				
18	income customers should be entitled to the benefits of the Homestead Program; and				
19	WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Topeka finds that the State of Kansas				
20	Homestead Program establishes a reasonable basis for a City of Topeka Utility Rebate				
21	Program to provide assistance to low income customers; and				
22	WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka hereby finds that the City's Water and				
23	Wastewater Utility Rate Refund Program be based on the same criteria as the State of				
24	Kansas Homestead Program Refund.				
25	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

27	Section 1. That The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended by

- Rate Refund Program in the City of Topeka. Subject to the terms and conditions established herein, eligible water and wastewater utility customers in the City of Topeka may receive a refund of the increase in the minimum monthly rate for water and wastewater rates paid by the residential utility customer for property located within the corporate limits of the City of Topeka. The water and wastewater utility rate refund shall be the amount the minimum monthly rate exceeds that in effect for water and wastewater on January 1, 2008.

 (b) Eligibility. Commencing January 1, 2009, only those utility customers who during the prior tax year fit the income and other requirements of the State of Kansas Homestead Property Tax Refund Law, as amended from time to time, and actually receive a refund from the State of Kansas homestead property tax refund program, as provided in K.S.A. 79-4501, et seq., as amended, may apply for water and wastewater utility refunds as
- 43 (c) Refund Procedure. Water and wastewater utility rate refunds shall be issued
 44 pursuant to the following procedure:
 - Application for a water and wastewater utility rate refund shall be made by September 5 of 2009 and of each subsequent year for the preceding tax year for which the utility customer paid water and wastewater utility rates.
 - 2. Applications shall be made on a form approved by the City of Topeka public works director and shall be accompanied by the following documents and information:
 - A. Proof that a homestead property tax refund claim form was filed and that a property tax refund was issued for the preceding calendar year.

57		<u>A.</u>	Upon receipt of the required application, documents and information,

69		<u>A.</u>	If the refund application is rejected for any reason, the public works

73			rejection to the City of Topeka City Manager whose decision on the
74			matter shall be deemed final and unappealable.

80	No person nor any city department shall be allowed free use of water, nor shall there			
81	be discrimination among water, wastewater or stormwater customers of like classes as to			
82	rates; and rebates in rates shall never be allowed to any person or city department except			
83	as an inducement to prompt payment of water, wastewater or stormwater rates unless			
84	otherwise provided in this chapter.			
85	Section 3. That section 146-147, No	free service or discrimination in rates, of The		
86	Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed:			
87	No free service or discrimination in rates.			
88	No person nor any city department sha	l be allowed free use of water, nor shall there		
89	be discrimination among water users of like classes as to rates; and rebates in rates shall			
90	never be allowed to any person or city department except as an inducement to prompt			
91	payment of water rates.			
92	Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its			
93	passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
