133	Section 3. Such assessments with accrued interest are hereby levied concurrent		
134	with general property taxes and shall be payable in twenty (20) equal annual installments;		
135	the first installment to be payable at the time of the first payment of the general property		
136	taxes, following the publication of this ordinance.		
137	Section 4. All assessments shall bear interest in an amount not to exceed the		
138	legal rate established by law.		
139	Section 5. The owner of any property so assessed may at any time prior to 30		
140	days from the date of publication of this ordinance, pay the whole of the assessment		
141	against any lot or parcel with interest accrued to the date of payment, to the City Treasurer.		
142	Section 6. Assessments not paid prior to the date provided in Section 5 hereof,		
143	shall be certified, together with interest accrued, or to accrue, by the City Clerk to the		
144	County Clerk, and collected in the same manner as other taxes.		
145	Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its		
146	passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
