	AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., concerning petty cash fund for water deposits, repealing City of Topeka Code § 322.
8 9	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:
10	Section 1. That section 2-322, Petty cash fund for water deposits, of The Code
11	the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.
12	Petty cash fund for water deposits.
13	(a) There is hereby established pursuant to K.S.A. 12-825a, a petty cash fund in the
14	sum of \$10,000.00 in the designated city depository bank for the use of the department
15	public works in the payment of refunds of water deposits made to secure payment
16	accounts and accrued interest; the sum of \$10,000.00 shall be charged to the general
17	water fund.
18	(b) The duly authorized, acting and qualified cashier or a bonded assistant of the
19	department of public works shall be and is hereby authorized to issue checks against the
20	petty cash fund for the sole purpose of refunding deposits and accrued interest, made
21	secure payment of accounts when the refunds are due and payable under the ordinance
22	of the city.
23	(c) The cashier shall clearly indicate on each check issued under subsection (b)
24	this section the purpose for which such check was issued. All such checks issued by the
25	cashier shall have provided thereon a certification by the payee of the check acknowledging
26	receipt of the refund.

(d) Whenever the petty cash fund becomes low or depleted the cashier shall prepare
vouchers covering such expenses as have been made from such petty cash fund, and shall
submit such vouchers together with the checks to the city council for audit, and allowance
of the amount from the water consumer fund of the department of public works. Warrants
issued therefor shall be payable to the petty cash fund and shall be deposited therein to
restore the petty cash fund to its original amount for use as provided in this section.
Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
