ORDINANCE NO. 19157

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-131007.00 (HTE #131700), which provides for upgrades to Fire Stations #1, #6 and #7, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby authorized, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka that the following public improvement be made:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project consists of providing professional design and construction services for complete upgrades to the existing kitchens and restrooms at Fire Station #1, located at 934 NE Quincy; Fire Station #6, located at 1419 NE Seward; and Fire Station #7, located at 1215 SW Oakley. The upgrades will include high efficiency plumbing and electrical fixtures, cabinetry, and general carpentry work to complete this project and comply with the current Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$318,240.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
