ORDINANCE NO. 19167

AN ORDINANCE introduced by Deputy Mayor Jeff Preisner amending City of Topeka Code § 110-35 concerning a quorum of the Topeka Planning Commission and specifically repealing said original section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That section 110-35, Quorum, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Quorum.

(a) A quorum of the Topeka Planning Commission shall consist of ~~seven (7)~~ five (5) members. Except as otherwise provided by state law requiring a higher number of affirmative votes, any matter requiring that a recommendation be made to the city council shall require the affirmative votes of not less than a majority of the ~~quorum present at such meeting~~ membership of the Topeka Planning Commission. The secretary shall record all votes taken by name, indicating whether the member voted in the affirmative or negative or abstained, and a copy of such record shall be transmitted to the city council following each meeting of the Topeka Planning Commission. The planning director shall serve as secretary to the Topeka Planning Commission. The secretary shall cause a proper record to be kept of all the proceedings of the Topeka Planning Commission.

Section 2. That section 110-35 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby specifically repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
