ORDINANCE NO. 19208

introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., amending City of Topeka Code § 50-64 concerning persons under arrest and specifically repealing said original section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That section 50-64, Persons under arrest; procedures; right to post bond; release on personal recognizance, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Persons under arrest; procedures; right to post bond; release on personal recognizance.

Any person arrested by a law enforcement officer shall be taken immediately by the law enforcement officer to the police station of the city or the office in the city designated by the municipal judge. At that time, the person shall have the right to post bond for the person's appearance, in accordance with section 50-66 and section 50-67, and amendments thereto. However, if the law enforcement officer has probable cause to believe that such person may cause injury to oneself or others, or damage to property, and there is no responsible person or institution to which the person might be released, the person shall remain in the protective custody of the law enforcement officer, in a city or county jail for a period not to exceed six hours, at which time such person shall be given an opportunity to post bond for the person's appearance. While so held in protective custody, the person shall be permitted to consult with counsel or other persons on the person's behalf. Any person who does not make bond for the person's appearance shall be placed in the city or county jail, to remain there until the person

29	makes bond for the person's appearance, or appears before the municipal court at the
30	earliest practical time, except that the person shall be released on the person's persona
31	recognizance to appear at a later date if the person has not made bond, has not
32	appeared before the municipal court within 4848 hours after arrest and if no warrant has
33	been issued for the person's arrest.
34	Section 2. That original section 50-64 of The Code of the City of Topeka
35	Kansas, is hereby specifically repealed.
36	Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
37	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
