3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19222**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., amending the
6 amount of the authorized project budget and authorizing the project
7 and amended budget for Improvement Project No. 70123-01, as more
8 specifically described herein, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code
9 of the City of Topeka, and repealing City of Topeka Ordinance No.
10 19144.

12 WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Topeka adopted Ordinance No. 19144,
13 effective on August 27, 2008, which authorized Improvement Project No. 70123-01 for
14 improvements to the intersection of Fairlawn and 29th Street and I-470; and

15 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 19144 authorized a total project cost of two million three
16 hundred seventy-two thousand three hundred eighty-one dollars (\$2,372,381.00) for
17 Improvement Project No. 70123-01; and

18 WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the ordinance to authorize the correct amount
19 for the project cost of two million six hundred seventy-two thousand three hundred eighty-
20 one dollars (\$2,672,381.00).

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
22 TOPEKA, KANSAS:

23 Section 1. That it is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and is also hereby
24 authorized pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka that the following
25 public improvement be made:

26 A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:
27

28 This project will provide for the rebuilding of the intersection of SW Fairlawn
29 and SW 29th Street and replacing the traffic signal. The project also provides
30 for adding traffic signals to the ramp south of 29th/Fairlawn and the ramp west
31 of 29th/Fairlawn and building a connector road.
