**ORDINANCE NO. 19236** 

introduced by Councilmember Jack Woelfel, amending City of Topeka Code § 2-331 concerning the expenditure of monies from the historic asset tourism fund and specifically repealing said original section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1</u>. That section 2-331, Historic asset preservation fund, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## Historic asset preservation tourism fund.

There is hereby created in the city a special fund to be known as the historic asset preservation tourism fund. Monies from the city's general fund, community block grant funds, any transient guest tax funds allocated to this fund, or funds from any other source legally available for such purpose shall be credited to this special fund. Monies so credited may be expended, upon approval by the city manager for the acquisition, rehabilitation and preservation of historic landmarks or historic resources located within the city. Monies deposited into this fund from the transient guest tax shall be expended only on projects of a public heritage tourism benefit located within the city and shall not be expended on projects that are private or primarily commercial in nature, unless open or intended to be open to the public on a regularly scheduled basis. Projects funded by transient guest taxthese funds shall be subject to the review and recommendations of athe Historic Sites for Heritage Tourism committee (Historic Tourism committee) consisting of the following members:

- Two members of the Landmarks Commission.
- b. Two members of the Topeka Tourism Alliance.
