ORDINANCE NO. 19292

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-701002.00 (HTE #702090), which provides for traffic signal replacement at 17th and MacVicar, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Improvement Project No. T-701002.00 (HTE #702090), with a project budget summarized herein and set forth fully in an attachment hereto, is hereby deemed advisable and necessary and it is also hereby authorized, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, that the following public improvement be made:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide for the replacement of existing traffic signal at the intersection of SW 17th Street and SW MacVicar Avenue.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$225,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
