3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19302**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor as part of the Sacred
7 Heart-St. Joseph Parish Autumnfest 2009 at specified locations and
8 times.

10 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
11 TOPEKA, KANSAS:

12 Section 1. a) Authorization is given to barricade a portion of the 200 block of
13 SW Van Buren Street right-of-way adjacent to the parking lot at the northeast corner of SW
14 3rd and Van Buren Streets on September 20, 2009 between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and
15 6:00 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours.
16 Licensed retailers may sell non-alcoholic commodities or food between the hours of 11:00
17 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on September 20, 2009.

18 b) The barricaded portion of the 200 block of SW Van Buren Street right-of-way
19 adjacent to the parking lot at the northeast corner of SW 3rd and Van Buren Streets shall
20 be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and the provisions of K.S.A. 41-719.
21 Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor
22 may in accordance with all applicable state laws and municipal ordinances sell alcoholic
23 liquor in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
24 barricaded portion of the 200 block of SW Van Buren Street right-of-way adjacent to the
25 parking lot at the northeast corner of SW 3rd and Van Buren Streets between the hours of
26 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on September 20, 2009.

27 c) Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages in the
28 specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded

portion of the 200 block of SW Van Buren Street right-of-way adjacent to the parking lot at the northeast corner of SW 3rd and Van Buren Streets between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on September 20, 2009.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be null and void on September 21, 2009.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
