18	public right-	public right-of-way nor is located closer than one foot from a public sidewalk.	
19	(3)	In "R" or "M" districts, fences beyond the front face of the principal	
20	structure sh	structure shall not exceed four feet in height.	
21	(b) Haza	ards:	
22	(1)	No fence shall be constructed which will constitute a traffic hazard,	
23	and no per	and no permit shall be granted for the construction of a fence until the city or	
24	county engi	county engineer has certified that the proposed fence will not constitute a traffic	
25	hazard.		
26	<u>(2)</u>	No fence shall be constructed in such a manner or design as to be	
27	hazardous	or dangerous to persons or animals.	

28	(c) The following shall constitute exceptions to the requirements of subsection	
29	(a) <u>;:</u>	
30	(1) Fences <u>located</u> in or <u>aroundupon</u> parks and <u>/or</u> recreational	
31	facilities; excepting those provided, however this exception shall not apply to	
32	recreational facilities which are accessory to a single-family dwelling.	
33	Section 2. That original § 48-29.03 of The Code of the City of Topeka,	
34	Kansas, is hereby specifically repealed.	
35	Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its	
36	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
