ORDINANCE NO. 19344

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-121000.00 (HTE #120650), which provides for the first phase of construction of the bridge on 49th Street over the Shunga Creek, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-121000.00 (HTE #120650) and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, that the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide for the first phase of the construction of a bridge over the South Tributary Branch of the Shunganunga Creek on SW 49th Street. This phase will include the design, right-of-way acquisition and utility relocation.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$154,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
