ORDINANCE NO. 19346

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-141000.02 (HTE #141282), which provides for the replacement of traffic signal controllers city-wide, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-141000.02 (HTE #141282) and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, that the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will procure approximately 30 new traffic signal controllers model 2070. The project is part of an ongoing replacement program to replace all city-owned traffic signal controllers, upgrading them to current technology.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$102,400.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
