ORDINANCE NO. 19360

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-301021.00 (HTE #303000), which provides for roof replacement of a zoo building, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-301021.00 (HTE #303000) and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, that the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide for removal and replacement of the existing roof covering on the Animal and Man building, which was constructed in 1966 and houses hippos, giraffes, small mammals, small reptiles and an education classroom. The project will include removal of existing covering, installation of insulation, a fully adhered membrane along with sealing, flashing and drainage improvements as needed.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$150,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
