**ORDINANCE NO. 19361**

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-301022.00 (HTE #303010), which provides for improvements to the Shunga, Deer Creek, Soldier and Oakland-Billard trail systems, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-301022.00 (HTE #303010) and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, that the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide for improvements to the existing trail systems of the Shunga, Deer Creek, Soldier and Oakland-Billard trails. The project will identify and correct deficiencies including, but not limited to, joint displacement, drainage problems, erosion control, settlement of concrete and cracked panels. The project will include removal and replacement of full concrete panels, grading of the area adjacent to the trail to improve drainage, signage improvements and all related appurtenances for a complete project.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$100,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
