17 <u>Section 2.</u> Owners of properties described in Section 1 above failed to construct

18 or reconstruct said sidewalk, requiring the City Engineer to cause the work to be done.

19 Said work is complete.

20 <u>Section 3.</u> Owners of properties described in Section 1 above have been given a

21 statement of costs associated with the work and have failed to pay said costs.

22 <u>Section 4.</u> The properties described in Section 1 are hereby assessed a service

23 assessment pursuant to the provisions of Topeka City Code § 130-376 and Topeka City

24 Code §§ 126-96 through 102 inclusive in the dollar amounts listed in Section 1 above.

25 <u>Section 5.</u> All service assessments may be paid in one installment or over a 26 period not to exceed three (3) years in equal annual installments with interest.

27 Section 6. Any service assessment remaining unpaid or for which less than one
28 third (1/3) of the total assessment has been paid, at the conclusion of one (1) year from the
29 date of publication of this Ordinance shall be certified by the City Clerk to the County Clerk
30 with interest on the unpaid assessed amount.

31 <u>Section 7.</u> No suit to set aside a service assessment shall be brought after the 32 expiration of thirty (30) days from the publication of the ordinance fixing the assessment.

33 <u>Section 8.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its 34 passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
