ORDINANCE NO. 19378

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-291009.00 (HTE #29119-00) which provides for the correction of inflow and infiltration into the City's sanitary collection system.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-291009.00 (HTE #29119-00) and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka that the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide for the correction of inflow and infiltration at specified locations in the City's sanitary collection system. Currently, combined dry weather flow at the North Topeka Wastewater Treatment Plant and the Oakland Wastewater Treatment Plant is 18 million gallons per day (MGD). Wet weather flow, depending on the magnitude of the storm event, can approach 90 million gallons per day. This increase in flow during wet weather is caused by the inflow and infiltration of stormwater into the sanitary sewer system.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$700,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

Combined water, wastewater, and stormwater utility operating funds and any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
