Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to sell alcoholic 18 liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and municipal ordinances sell 19 alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street between the 20 21 hours of 10:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on May 8, 2010. 22 Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages Section 3. 23 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street between the hours of 24 25 10:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on May 8, 2010. 26 Section 2. This Ordinance shall be null and void on May 9, 2010. 27 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, Section 3. 28 approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
