	AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., amending City of Topeka Code § 2-224, concerning the Topeka Metropolitan Transit Authority and specifically repealing said original section.			
	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:			
	Section 1. That section 2-224, Topeka Metropolitan Transit Authority, of The			
12	Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:			
13	Topeka Metropolitan Transit Authority.			
14	(a) <i>Cited.</i> The City of Topeka, adopted the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act,			
15	K.S.A. 12-2801 et seq. and amendments thereto (the "Act") and by Charter Ordinance			
16	has made certain provisions of the Act inapplicable to the city and provided certain			
17	substitute provisions therefor.(Charter Ordinance 23, § 4 as amended by Charter			
18	Ordinance 52, § 2 [App. A, § A12-20]). The governing and administrative body of the			
19	Topeka Metropolitan Transit Authority shall be known as the transit board. The transit			
20	board shall conduct business in accordance with the charter ordinances as adopted and			
21	amended and its franchise as granted.			
22	(b) Membership. The terms and conditions of membership of the board shall			
23	be governed by Topeka City Code § A9-1 et seq. The board shall consist of five			
24	members who are registered voters, residents of the metropolitan area and recognized			
25	for business ability. Members shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the			
26	council and shall serve for four year terms.			
27	Section 2. That original § 2-224 of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is			
28	hereby specifically repealed.

29	Section 3.	This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
30	passage, approval	and publication in the official City newspaper.

- 31 <u>Section 4</u>. All ordinances, resolutions or rules, or portions thereof, inconsistent 32 with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby rescinded or repealed.
- 33 <u>Section 5</u>. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared 34 to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of 35 this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be 36 invalid.
