3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19440**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location
7 and time for The Office and Celtic Fox on July 10, 2010.

9 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
10 TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

11 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of the sidewalk adjacent to
12 124 SW 8th Street and 118 SW 8th Street on July 10 2010, between the hours of 10:00 a.m.
13 and 11:59 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours.

14 Section 2. The barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8th Street
15 and 118 SW 8th Street shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and the
16 provisions of K.S.A. 41-719. Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of
17 Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and
18 municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of
19 Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW
20 8th Street and 118 SW 8th Street between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on July
21 10, 2010.

22 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
23 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
24 barricaded portion of the sidewalk adjacent to 124 SW 8th and 118 SW 8th Street between
25 the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on July 10, 2010.

26 Section 4. This Ordinance shall be null and void on July 11, 2010.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
