4 **ORDINANCE NO. 19463**

6 AN ORDINANCE introduced Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,
7 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location
8 and time for "Ride for the Red" on September 11, 2010.

10 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
11 TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

12 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of 8th Street between
13 Jackson Street and Kansas Avenue on September 11, 2010, between the hours of 1:00
14 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these
15 hours.

16 Section 2. The barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson Street and
17 Kansas Avenue shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and the
18 provisions of K.S.A. 41-719. Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of
19 Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and
20 municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of
21 Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson
22 Street and Kansas Avenue between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. on September
23 11, 2010.

24 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
25 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
26 barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson Street and Kansas Avenue between the
27 hours of 1:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. on September 11, 2010.

28 Section 4. This Ordinance shall be null and void on September 12, 2010.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.

PASSED and APPROVED by the City Council August 31, 2010.
