ORDINANCE NO. 19517

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-301030.00, which provides for player, spectator and visitor improvements to Felker Park and Rueger Park softball complexes, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-301030.00 and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide for player, spectator and visitor improvements to the softball complexes at Felker Park, located at 3540 SW Gage Boulevard, and Rueger Park, located at 2801 SW Kansas Avenue. Improvements include renovations to 16 player dugouts, renovation of 8 spectator areas including the addition of shade structures, renovations to areas for visitors outside the field areas including the addition of open air shelters, and other related amenities.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$130,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
