ORDINANCE NO. 19519

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-301029.00, which provides for improvements to gym floors in Oakland and Garfield community centers, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-301029.00 and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide the installation of a 7,500 square foot wood gym floor over the existing synthetic floor in Oakland Community Center. Installation of a 4,700 square foot wood gym floor over the existing synthetic floor in Garfield Community Center. Doorway thresholds will be modified to allow for the change in floor elevation and maintain compliance with the ADA.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$208,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
