ORDINANCE NO. 19530

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-841013.00 which provides for the maintenance and improvement of existing streets, as more specifically described herein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project

No. T-841013.00 and also hereby authorizes that the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide maintenance and improvements to existing city streets, gutters, sidewalks, alleys and street lighting. Maintenance and improvements will be limited to elements which are already in place and in need of maintenance, repair, or replacement, as determined by the engineer.
