	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:		
13 14	Section 1.	That section 13.10.190, Equipment authorized, of the Code of the	
15	City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:		
16	Operations, maintenance and funding. Equipment authorized.		
17	The water utility shall include fluoridation in the drinking water treatment		
18	operations, as determined by the public works director, or his or her designee, and as		
19	recommended by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.		
20	Funds for e	quipment, operations and maintenance expenses to fluoridate the	
21	city's water supply system shall be provided from the water, water pollution control, and		
22	stormwater utility fund.		
23	The water division is hereby directed and authorized to install and operate		
24	equipment which will introduce sufficient fluoride compound to raise the fluoride		
25	concentration in the finished water to one part of fluoride for every million parts of water		
26	being distributed to the water supply system of the city, or such concentration as is		
27	ordered from time to time by the state Board of Health.		
28	Section 2.	That section 13.10.200, Operation under supervision of water	
29	division, of the Cod	e of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.	

)	Operation under supervision of water division.		
	The water division shall operate such fluoride and make such periodic		
	inspections as in its judgment may be deemed necessary to safeguard the health and		
	welfare of the citizens of the city, and the water division is hereby made responsible for		
•	the expedient, safe, proper and efficient operation of such fluoridation.		
	Section 3. That section 13.10.210, Operation expense from water utility fund,		
;	of the Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby repealed.		
•	Operation expense from water utility fund.		
	Operating funds for fluoridation of the city water supply system shall be provided		
	from the water utility fund.		
	Section 4. That original § 13.10.190 of The Code of the City of Topeka,		
	Kansas is hereby specifically repealed.		
	Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its		
	passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.		
	Section 6. This ordinance shall supersede any ordinances, resolutions or		
	rules, or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.		
	Section 7. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared		
	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this		
	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
