4 5 6 7 8	AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Jeff Preisner concerning fence height, amending City of Topeka Code § 18.210.040 and specifically repealing said original section.
9 10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA:
11	Section 1. That section 18.210.040, Fences, of The Code of the City of
12	Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:
13	Fences.
14	(a) Location and Height. Fences and hedges shall be subject to the following
15	location and height requirements:
16	(1) Except as provided in subsection (c), Nno portion of a fence shall
17	exceed eight feet in height.
18	(2) Fences and hedges shall be located so no part thereof extends into
19	public right-of-way nor is located closer than one foot from a public sidewalk.
20	(3) In R <u>orand</u> M districts, fences beyond the front face of the principal
21	structure shall not exceed four feet in height. On corner lots, but not including
22	reversed corner lots, fences beyond the front face of the principal structure where
23	the fence is located along an arterial street that runs perpendicular to the corner
24	lots' established rear yard shall not exceed six feet in height. On reversed corner
25	lots, fence heights shall be limited to four feet within all required front yards. On
26	double frontage lots, fence heights shall be limited to four feet where such lots
27	abut the established minimum front yard of any adjoining lot.
28	(b) Hazards. Notwithstanding subsection (a), no fence shall be constructed:

29	(1) No fence shall be constructed which will constitute a traffic hazard
30	and no permit shall be granted for the construction of a fence until upor
31	determination by the city or county engineer has certified that the proposed fence
32	will not constitutes a traffic hazard;
33	(2) the location of the fence creates a site obstruction, such as within a
34	site distance triangle, as prohibited by Chapter 12.20 Public Traffic Hazards; or
35	(23) No fence shall be constructed in such a manner or design as to be
36	hazardous or dangerous to persons or animals.
37	(c) The following shall constitute exceptions to the requirements of subsection
38	(a)(1)-of this section:
39	(1) Fences located in or upon parks and/or recreational facilities
40	provided, however, this exception shall not apply to recreational facilities which
41	are accessory to a single-family dwelling.
42	(2) Fences located in or upon public use facilities or public utility
43	facilities, such as electrical substations or pumping stations, shall be limited to
44	eight feet in height unless the Planning Director determines that additional height
45	not to exceed nine feet, is necessary for public health and safety.
46	Section 2. That original § 18.210.040 of The Code of the City of Topeka
47	Kansas, is hereby specifically repealed.
48	Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
49	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.
50	Section 4. This ordinance shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules
51	or portions thereof, which are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance.

52	Section 5. Should any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared
53	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this
54	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
