ORDINANCE NO. 19548

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-131015.00, which provides for various improvements to City owned facilities, as more specifically described herein, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-131015.00 and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide the design and construction services for the improvements to various City of Topeka facilities. The improvements consist of concrete apron repairs at selected fire stations, Holliday building parking deck repairs, Law Enforcement Center carpet replacement, redesign and replacement of heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system at Fire Station #11 and electrical repairs at Fire Stations 4 and 7 at the Topeka Performing Arts Center and selected fire stations.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$427,000.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

<u>Fleet Management Fund</u>	<u>\$ 4,000.00</u>
<u>General Fund Contingency</u>	<u>\$214,000.00</u>
General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds	<u>\$209,000.00</u>
