3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19561**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember John Alcala authorizing the sale,  
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at specified locations  
7 and times for the 2011 Germanfest celebration on June 4 and 5, 2011,  
8 to be held at Sacred Heart-St. Joseph Parish.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,  
11 KANSAS, that:

12 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade certain portions of NE Freeman  
13 Street, NE Rowley Street, NE Greeley Street and an east-west alley on the south side of  
14 the church hall between Seward Avenue and Greeley Street as designated on the map  
15 attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Designated Barricaded Area") on June 4, 2011, between  
16 the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. and on June 5, 2011, between the hours of 10:00  
17 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these  
18 hours.

19 Section 2. The Designated Barricaded Area shall be temporarily removed from  
20 the City's right-of-way and exempt from the provisions of K.S.A. 41-719(c). Vendors  
21 holding the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in  
22 accordance with all applicable state laws and municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in  
23 the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the  
24 Designated Barricaded Area on June 4, 2011, between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 11:00  
25 p.m. and on June 5, 2011, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

26 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages  
27 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the

Designated Barricaded Areas on June 4, 2011, between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. and on June 5, 2011, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Section 4. The Germanfest is hereby granted a temporary special event retailers permit to sell, offer, and serve cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2703, as amended.

Section 5. The Germanfest is hereby approved as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645 as amended.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be null and void on June 6, 2011.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
