ORDINANCE NO. 19569

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., amending City of Topeka Code § 18.50.060, concerning zoning district boundaries and specifically repealing said original section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY THE CITY OF TOPEKA:

Section 1. That section 18.50.060, Rules where uncertainty may arise, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Rules where uncertainty may arise Determining zoning district boundaries.

Where uncertainty exists with respect to the In determining boundaries of the various zoning districts as shown on the "district map," the following rules shall apply:

- (a) The district boundaries are eitherthe city limits or the centerlines of rightsof-way including: streets, or alleys, railways, creeks, streams, rivers, or drainage
 channels unless otherwise shown, and where the districts designated on the map are
 bounded approximately by street or alley lines, the street or alley shall be construed to
 be the boundary of the district.
- (b) Where the district boundaries are not otherwise indicated and where the property has been or may hereafter be divided into blocks and lots, the district boundaries shall be construed to be the lot lines, and where the districts are bounded approximately by lot lines, the lot lines shall be construed to be the boundary of the districts unless the boundaries are otherwise indicated on the map.
- (c) In unsubdivided propertyproperties that are not subdivided, the district boundary lines on the map shall be determined by use of the scale appearing on the map.
