ORDINANCE NO. 19574

AN ORDINANCE introduced by City Manager Norton N. Bonaparte, Jr., authorizing Improvement Project No. T-301034.00, which provides for new roofing system for the rainforest at the Zoo, as more specifically described herein, all pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it hereby deems advisable and necessary Improvement Project No. T-301034.00 and also hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section A12-1 of the Code of the City of Topeka, the public improvement be made as follows:

A. GENERAL NATURE OF IMPROVEMENT:

This project will provide the design and construction of a new roofing system, fire sprinkler system and a new addition at the Topeka Zoological Park Rain Forest. The project will require acrylic lens replacement of the dome, a new 60 mil thermoplastic (TPO) membrane roofing system for the support areas, a new building fire sprinkler system, and a new 1,118 square foot building addition.

B. TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET COST:

\$1,211,527.00

C. SOURCE OF FUNDS:

General Obligation Bonds or any other lawfully available funds.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
