94	Section 6.	Assessments not paid prior to the date provided in Section 5 hereof,	
95	shall be certified, together with interest accrued, or to accrue, by the City Clerk to the		
96	County Clerk, and collected in the same manner as other taxes.		
97	Section 7.	This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its	
98	passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
