3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19592**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember John Alcala authorizing the sale,  
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor as part of the 2011  
7 Fiesta Mexicana at specified locations and times.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,  
10 KANSAS, that:

11 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of Atchison Avenue  
12 between NE Chandler and NE Lake Streets and NE Chandler Street between Greeley  
13 Street and Atchison Avenue from July 12, 2011, through July 16, 2011, between the hours  
14 of 4:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between  
15 these hours. Licensed retailers may sell non-alcoholic commodities or food from July 12,  
16 2011, and July 16, 2011, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.

17 Section 2. The barricaded portion of Atchison Avenue between Chandler and NE  
18 Lake Streets and NE Chandler Street between Greeley Street and Atchison Avenue shall  
19 be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and exempt from the provisions of  
20 K.S.A. 41-719(c). Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of Kansas to sell  
21 alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and municipal ordinances  
22 sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage  
23 Control within the barricaded portion of Atchison Avenue between Chandler and NE Lake  
24 Streets and NE Chandler Street between Greeley Street and Atchison Avenue from July  
25 12, 2011, and July 16, 2011, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.

26 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages  
27 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the

barricaded portion of Atchison Avenue between Chandler and NE Lake Streets and NE Chandler Street between Greeley Street and Atchison Avenue from July 12, 2011, and July 16, 2011, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.

Section 4. The Fiesta Mexicana is hereby granted a temporary special event retailers permit to sell, offer, and serve cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2703, as amended.

Section 5. The Fiesta Mexicana is hereby approved as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645, as amended.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be null and void on July 17, 2011.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
