	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,		
10	KANSAS, that:		
11	Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of SE 9 th Street between		
12	SE Quincy and S. Kansas Avenue on July 8, 2011, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and		
13	11:59 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours.		
14	Licensed retailers may sell non-alcoholic commodities or food on July 8, 2011, between the		
15	hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.		
16	Section 2. The barricaded portion of SE 9 th Street between SE Quincy and S.		
17	Kansas Avenue shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and exempt from		
18	the provisions of K.S.A. 41-719(c). Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State		
19	of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and		
20	municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of		
21	Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of SE 9 th Street between SE Quincy		
22	and S. Kansas Avenue on July 8, 2011, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.		
23	Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages		
24	in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the		
25	barricaded portion of SE 9 th Street between SE Quincy and S. Kansas Avenue on July 8,		
26	2011, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.		

Section 4.	The Fiesta Mexicana is hereby granted a temporary special event	
retailers permit to se	ell, offer, and serve cereal malt beverages for consumption on the	
premises pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2703, as amended.		
Section 5.	The Fiesta Mexicana is hereby approved as a special event as	
required by K.S.A. 41-2645, as amended.		
Section 6.	This Ordinance shall be null and void on July 9, 2011.	
Section 7.	This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage,	
approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
