	Section 1. That section § 14.30.010, National Electrical Code – Adopted, of		
13	The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:		
14	National Electrical Code – Adopted.		
15	There is hereby adopted by reference the National Electrical Code, 20082011		
16	Edition, and any codified supplements thereto, as promulgated by the National Fire		
17	Protection Association, Quincy, Massachusetts. The National Electrical Code,		
18	20082011 Edition, is hereby adopted as the electrical code of the city and incorporated		
19	in this chapter as if fully set out in this chapter.		
20	Section 2. That section § 14.30.060, Amendments to the NEC, of The Code of		
21	the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:		
22	Amendments to the NEC.		
23	Amendments to the National Electrical Code adopted herein shall be set out in		
24	this section.		
25	Section 90.2, Scope (B) Not Covered (5), of the National Electrical Code shall be		
26	deleted in its entirety and the following provisions shall be substituted therefor:		
27	(5) Installations under the exclusive control of an electric utility where such		
28	installations:		
29	a. Consist of service drops or service laterals, and associated metering, or		

b. Are located (i) in legally established easements or rights-of-way, (ii) pursuant					
to a utility's tariff approved by the public service commission, utility commission, or other					
regulatory agency having jurisdiction over such utility, or (iii) pursuant to other					
applicable law or regulation, or					

c. Are on property owned or leased by the electric utility for the purpose of communications, metering, generation, control transformation, transmission or distribution of electric energy.

Section 110.24, Available Fault Current of the National Electrical code shall be deleted in its entirety and the following provisions shall be substituted therefor:

Field Marking. New and replaced service equipment in other than dwelling units shall be legibly marked in the field with the maximum available fault current. The field marking(s) shall include the date the fault current calculation was performed and be of sufficient durability to withstand the environment involved.

<u>Exception: The field marking requirements in 110.24 shall not be required in industrial installations where conditions of maintenance and supervision ensure that only qualified persons service the equipment.</u>

Section 3. That section § 14.30.130, Required, of The Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## Required Permit.

(a) Required. Every person, before entering upon any construction or erection of any electric light or power wiring in any new building in the city, any original installation in any building or any alteration, shall make application to the development

54	(b) Exception. An electrical permit is not required if the project doesn't require		
55	a building permit and the installation meets the following requirements:		
56	(1) General elect	rical maintenance.

59	(4) Extension of	an existing 125 volt 15 or 20 amp branch circuit not	
60	more than four (4) opening	gs and thirty (30) feet in length with the exception of	
61	locations covered by Chapters 5-7 of the National Electrical Code.		
62	Section 4. That original	§ 14.30.010, § 14.30.060 and § 14.30.130 of The	
63	Code of the City of Topeka, Kansas, are hereby specifically repealed.		
64	Section 5. This ordinance	ce shall take effect and be in force from and after its	
65	passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.		
66	Section 6. This ordinance	e shall supersede all ordinances, resolutions or rules,	
67	or portions thereof, which are in co	onflict with the provisions of this ordinance.	
68	Section 7. Should any se	ection, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared	
69	invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of this		
70	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
