3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19629**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor at a specified location
7 and time for "Ride for the Red" event to be held on September 10,
8 2011.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,
11 KANSAS, that:

12 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of 8th Street between
13 Jackson Street and Kansas Avenue on September 10, 2011, between the hours of 1:00
14 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these
15 hours.

16 Section 2. The barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson Street and
17 Kansas Avenue shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and exempt from
18 the provisions of K.S.A. 41-719(c). Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State
19 of Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and
20 municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of
21 Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson
22 Street and Kansas Avenue on September 10, 2011, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and
23 11:59 p.m.

24 Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages
25 in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the
26 barricaded portion of 8th Street between Jackson Street and Kansas Avenue on September
27 10, 2011, between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m.

Section 4. The KCAC American Red Cross is hereby granted a temporary special event retailers permit to sell, offer, and serve cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2703, as amended.

Section 5. The Ride for the Red is hereby approved as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645, as amended.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be null and void on September 11, 2011.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.

PASSED and APPROVED by the Governing Body August 23, 2011.
