3 **ORDINANCE NO. 19630**

5 AN ORDINANCE introduced by Councilmember Karen Hiller authorizing the sale,  
6 consumption and possession of alcoholic liquor as part of the Let's  
7 Help Music Fest on September 3, 2011, at specified locations and  
8 times.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF TOPEKA,  
11 KANSAS, that:

12 Section 1. Authorization is given to barricade a portion of Kansas Avenue south of  
13 1<sup>st</sup> Street through 4<sup>th</sup> Street as well as portions of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets between Jackson  
14 Street and Quincy Street on September 3, 2011, between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 11:00  
15 p.m. Attendance to the celebration is open to the public between these hours. Licensed  
16 retailers may sell non-alcoholic commodities or food from on September 3, 2011, between  
17 the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. Admission is open to the public between these  
18 hours.

19 Section 2. The barricaded portion of Kansas Avenue south of 1<sup>st</sup> Street through  
20 4<sup>th</sup> Street as well as portions of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets between Jackson Street and Quincy  
21 Street shall be temporarily removed from the City's right-of-way and exempt from the  
22 provisions of K.S.A. 41-719(c). Vendors holding the appropriate license from the State of  
23 Kansas to sell alcoholic liquor may in accordance with all applicable state laws and  
24 municipal ordinances sell alcoholic liquor in the specific area designated by the division of  
25 Alcohol Beverage Control within the portion of Kansas Avenue south of 1<sup>st</sup> Street through  
26 4<sup>th</sup> Street as well as portions of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets between Jackson Street and Quincy  
27 Street on September 3, 2011, between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.

Section 3. Event attendees may buy, possess and consume alcoholic beverages in the specific area designated by the division of Alcohol Beverage Control within the barricaded portion of Kansas Avenue south of 1<sup>st</sup> Street through 4<sup>th</sup> Street as well as portions of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Streets between Jackson Street and Quincy Street on September 3, 2011, between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m.

Section 4. The Let's Help, Inc. is hereby granted a temporary special event retailers permit to sell, offer, and serve cereal malt beverages for consumption on the premises pursuant to K.S.A. 41-2703, as amended.

Section 5. The Let's Help Music Fest is hereby approved as a special event as required by K.S.A. 41-2645, as amended.

**Section 6.** This Ordinance shall be null and void on September 3, 2011.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
